The story behind our name – Café 1911

George and Julia Palmer formed their business which today is known as **Palmers Garden Centre**. It is still owned and run by the 4th and 5th Generations of the Palmer Family and is totally independent.

George and Julia's son Harold married Ida in 1932 and their only son Brian was born in 1936. After his National Service with the Army, he joined the family business and in the early 1960's turned a thriving Nursery into an early garden centre. Today Brian's children, Caroline and Rob (great grandchildren of George and Julia) are at the helm of the 1911 family business.

Also, in 1911

The top 10 baby names in 1911 were - Mary, Helen, Margaret, Dorothy, Ruth, John, William, James, George, Robert.

International Women's day was celebrated for the first time on March 19th 1911.

King George V was crowned at Westminster Abbey on June 22nd

Summer 1911 was the hottest since records began in 1880.

The Ocean Liner Titanic was launched on May 31st in Belfast prior to undergoing sea trials. Her Maiden voyage started in Southampton a year later on 10th April 1912 and ended after 5 days on 15th April after striking an iceberg in the North Atlantic.

Her sister ship the RMS Olympic sailed for Liverpool also on May 31st 1911 at the start of her first transatlantic crossing. She reached New York on 21st June 1911 at the end of her maiden voyage. She had a working career spanning 24 years.

Former President of the United States of America and former Actor Ronald Reagan was born on February 6th 1911.

Ginger Rogers - American stage and film dancer and actor and partner of Fred Astaire was born 16th July 1911.

Vincent Price – born 27th May 1911 - Actor best known for his horror films with his last film Edward Scissorhands filmed in 1990. He provided the voice over for Michael Jackson music video 'Thriller'.

Danny Kaye – Born 18th January 1911. Broadway actor, singer, dancer, comedian, musician and entertainer. Famous film and beautiful movie – White Christmas starring Danny Kaye and Bing Crosby released in 1954. His personal Quote – 'Life is a great big canvas: throw all the paint you can at it'.

On October 24th 1911 British Explorer Robert Scott left Cape Evans on the west side of Ross Island, Antarctica in the race for the Pole against Norwegian explorer Roald Amundsen. On 14th December 1911 Amundsen raised the flag of Norway. Scott reached the Pole a month later on 17th January 1912. Sadly, Scott died on the return Journey in March 1912.

In 1911 Marie Curie won her second Nobel prize for chemistry and her work on radioactivity. She had previously won half of the Nobel prize for Physics in 1903 with her husband. The other half of the prize was for Antoine Becquerel for their joint work into the study of spontaneous radiation. In the 21st Century, The Marie Curie foundation is now a major UK charity.
